Hello. We are all the Burmese students from our RIS and RIST community and we are here to ask the whole Ruamrudee family to help the people of Burma. So please spare us a few minutes of your time as we tell you what happened and ask for your help. As you all know a devastating cyclone hit Burma on May 3, 2008. Many parts of the country are completely destroyed. Many thousands upon thousands of people have lost their lives. Whole towns have disappeared. The cyclone has destroyed millions of homes and rice fields all over Burma, particularly in the Irrawady Delta. This tragic event has caught

everyone's attention all over the world. According to the news from the Burmese government, more than 22,000 people are reported dead and more than half a million people still missing. It is expected that these numbers will climb dramatically as more reports come in. Helping agencies such as the United Nations, Save the Children, and the Red Cross are assisting the people by providing first aid, water, food, clothing and all other basic needs. People have lost everything. People have nothing.



We ask for your help in donating anything you can for these people in such desperate need. They need everything that we can collect -- cash, clothing, food such as canned goods, and dry goods such as noodles, rice and medical supplies. This is about giving to those in need. Ruamrudee is a school who cares and stands for the Union of Hearts. Caring is sharing, and giving to those in need is the best way of showing that you care. So please bring us what you can. All these donations will be transported to Burma to be distributed to the people in need.
